Dress Code Information

Jackets, sweaters, coats, etc. (WRITE STUDENT NAME IN ALL ITEMS)

- Any kind of jacket/coat/sweater is OK if it meets regular dress code expectations
 - May not be disruptive, distracting, display offensive language/symbols, etc.
 - School staff may ask students to remove jackets when it is above 80 degrees outside.
- Any pullover garment that is worn all day (sweater, sweater vest, sweatshirt) should have a collar OR be worn with a collared uniform shirt or official school t-shirt underneath. It must be solid white, solid navy or the school's additional solid shirt color. Hoodies may not be worn with the hood on the head.

Bottoms: Navy, black, khaki/tan, denim

- Shorts, pants, skorts, skirts, skirted jumpers
- SHORTS MUST BE MID-THIGH OR LONGER IN LENGTH
- **Must be plain, solid-color twill, corduroy or denim fabric**
- Traditional blue jean color is OK for denim, no other jean colors
- NO HOLES

Tops: White, Navy, Burgundy, Hunter Green (NO RED)

- Must have long or short sleeves
- Knit polo-type or woven dress shirts, blouses, turtlenecks
- School t-shirts are OK

Shoes: For safety purposes around campus:

- Traditional tennis shoes or rubber soled shoes MUST be worn daily
- Socks are required with all tennis shoes
- Laces or Velcro on tennis shoes must be tied/fastened as designed
- Footwear that is NOT PERMITTED in order to protect our historic gym floor from scratches, twisted ankles/sprains and avoiding falls on our steps: **boots, flip flops, slides, CROCS, open toe sandals stacked heeled shoes or shoes with wheels.**

Other Dress Code Rules

The Dress Code **does not allow** for clothing with colored trim, stripes, embroidery, decoration, etc. It also does not provide for overalls (overalls with pants or shorts), sweat pants, knit pants/skirts, leggings, etc.

- Artificial nails, make-up, excessive and large jewelry items are **NOT permitted.**
- A **BELT** is required if the garment has belt loops
- Shirts (including t-shirts) must be tucked in
- Hair color must be a natural color: Unnatural colors are not permitted (ex. Purple, pink, blue)
- Shorts/skirts must be mid-thigh or longer
- Clothes must be appropriate size, with waist of garment worn at student's waist
- Clothing that is too tight or too loose is not appropriate for school
- A small logo is acceptable

School administration will determine if clothing is appropriate for school and complies with district and school rules. For more information, please refer to the Code of Student Conduct for a copy of the student dress code.

Faded denim, leggings and "jeggings", and knit material is NOT permitted.



Clothing may not have holes or torn pieces of material on pants or shirts.
